French Onion Salisbury Steak – Makes 4 Steaks, Total Time – 45 minutes

1 ¼ Pounds Ground Chuck	1-Teaspoon Sugar
¼ Cup Fresh Minced Parsley	1 Tablespoon Garlic, minced
2 Tablespoons Scallions, minced	1-Tablespoon Tomato Paste
1-Tablespoon Salt	2 Cups Beef Broth
½ Teaspoon Black Pepper	¼ Cup Dry Red Wine
2 Tablespoons All-Purpose Flour	¾ Teaspoon Salt
1-Tablespoon Olive Oil	½ Teaspoon Dried Thyme Leaves
2 Cups Onions, sliced	4 Teaspoons Parmesan Cheese, shredded

Combine chuck, parsley, scallion, salt and pepper. Divide evenly into 4 portions and shape each into oval patties. Place flour in a shallow dish; dredge each patty in flour. Reserve remaining flour.

Heat olive oil in a sauté pan over medium-high heat. Add patties and sauté 3 minutes on each side or until browned. Remove from pan. Add onions and sugar to pan; sauté 5 minutes. Stir in garlic and tomato paste; sauté 1 minute or until paste begins to brown. Sprinkle onions with reserved flour; cook 1 minute. Stir in broth and wine, then add the salt and thyme.

Return meat to pan and bring soup to a boil. Reduce heat to medium-low, cover and simmer 10 minutes.

Serve steaks on ****Cheese Toasts**** with onion soup ladled over. Garnish with Parmesan cheese.

Cheese Toasts – Makes 4 Toasts, Total Time – 20 minutes

4 Slices French Bread, cut diagonally ½ inch thick	Pinch of Paprika
2 Tablespoons Unsalted Butter	½ Cup Swiss Cheese, grated
½ teaspoon Garlic, minced	1 Tablespoon Parmesan Cheese, grated

Preheat oven to 400 degrees

Place bread on baking sheet. Combine butter, garlic and paprika and spread on one side of each slice of bread. Combine cheeses and sprinkle evenly over butter. Bake until bread is crisp and cheese is bubbly, 10 – 15 minutes.
